Last February our CEO, Donald Sanderson asked that the Foundation buy a new \$650,000 machine. We have been scrambling to stay on track with a very aggressive fundraising schedule ever since!

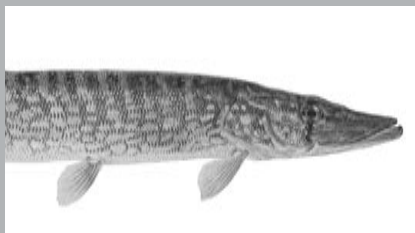
Our current analog mammography machine at the Health Centre is 12 years old. The screen resolution lacks clarity making a new machine critical to continued participation in the Ontario Breast Screening Program. The Health Centre has been an accredited partner in the program since its inception in 1990. The goal is to have 70% of all women between the ages of 50 – 69 screened regularly. Since 1990 when the program began the number of women participating locally has increased. The Health Centre now screens 2,000 women on an annual basis.

The program is critical to local families as women in remote areas have less choice and more cost if forced to travel outside of the community for screening. These factors are prohibitive to regular screening. And screening is important. Because of screening and early detection mortality rates have dropped by 20% since 1986. Our mothers, daughters and sisters require current technology that is locally accessible if they are to be on the winning side of the statistics.

Every dollar raised this evening will help the cause. Local families will benefit from your support so thank you for buying a ticket and sharing the summer's evening with us. But don't stop there.
